






Community Affairs

Overview:

On April 12, Officer Joe Sulaica and Officer Matt Miller attended the 22nd Annual Sylvania Spring Expo and Market. Events were held at Sylvania Tam-O-Shanter and open to the public. This exhibition features several businesses and organizations within the City of Sylvania and Sylvania Township. Fun for the whole family, this event is the perfect way to network with other local businesses, learn more about local organizations, entertain the kids in the "Kids Zone," and (our favorite) meet your Sylvania Township Police!



The bi-annual National Drug Take Back Day occurred this month on April 26, 2025. In cooperation with the Sylvania Prevention Alliance and the Sylvania City Police Department, a total of 170.80 pounds of unused medications were collected in this four-hour period! Officer Matt Miller and Officer Joe Sulaica, property room asst. Stacie Smothers, as well as Sylvania City officers and Alumni from the Citizen Police Academy. Kroger, located at 7545 Sylvania Ave, graciously provided space in their parking lot for the event. The surrendered drugs were collected by the DEA for proper disposal. The next Take Back event is October 25, 2025, and members of the community are always welcome to bring their unused medications to our drug drop box in the STPD lobby during normal business hours.

On April 3, 2025, Officers Matt Miller and Joe Sulaica, assisted by Ohio Department of Public Safety (Ohio Investigative Unit) and funded by the Sylvania Prevention Alliance, completed a series of Alcohol Compliance Checks on local businesses. A total of 17 checks were completed to ensure that these businesses are not selling alcohol to minors. We are pleased to announce we found only one business in violation.
