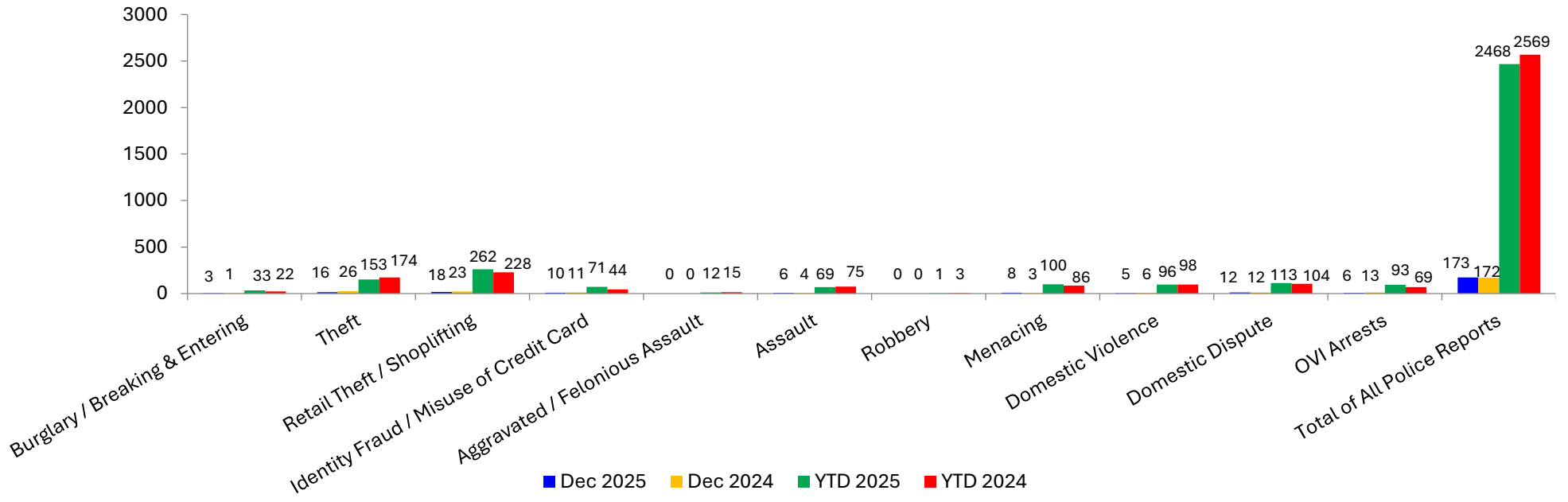




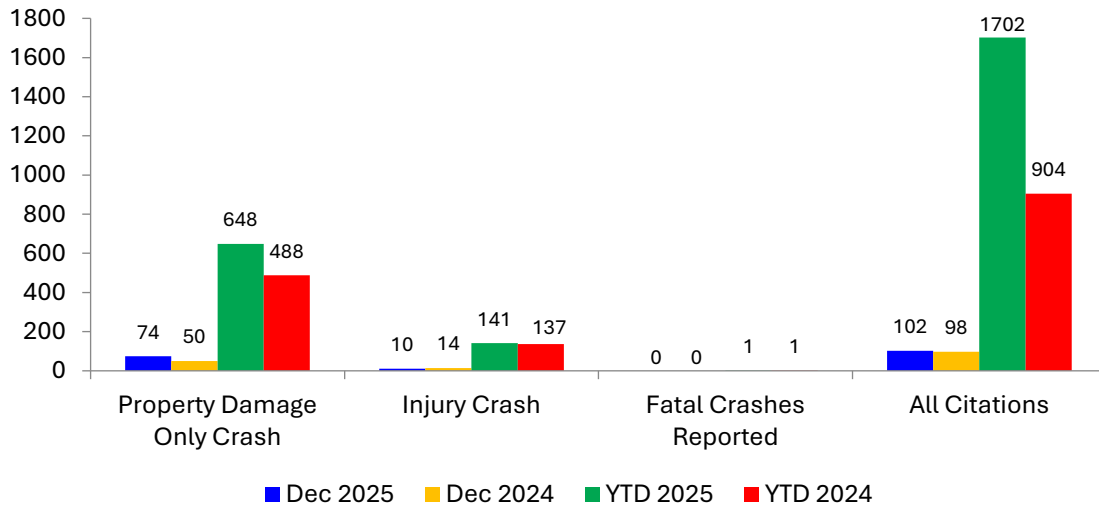

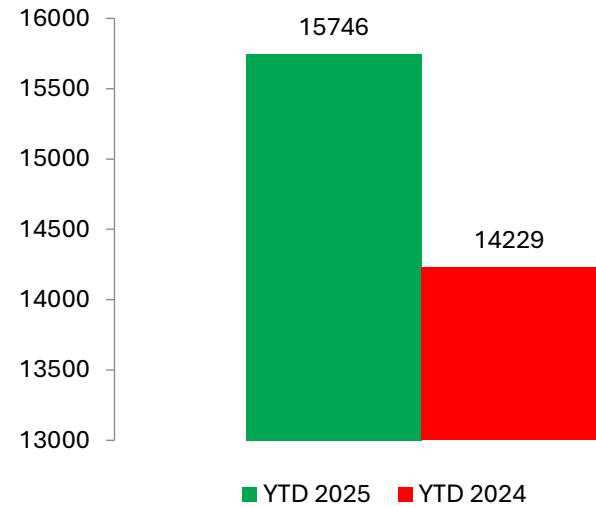

DEA 4th Quarter

During the 4th quarter of 2025, I participated in several search warrants and operations resulting in the seizure of the below listed drugs of abuse as well as valuable assets. I continue to investigate leads in the DEA cases that I have that are currently open. Additionally, I continue to manage confidential sources with the purpose of disrupting interstate drug trafficking networks which have a nexus to Northwest Ohio.

The United States Postal Service Mail Carrier who was discussed in the previous quarterly report has plead guilty and was sentenced in Lucas County Common Pleas Court to 6 months in the Correctional Treatment Facility.

An individual who was contacted by Sylvania Township Officers several years ago and was mentioned in the 4th quarter 2024 quarterly report, has communicated his intention to plead guilty to charges in Federal Court related to being a felon in possession of a firearm and child pornography related charges. His change of plea hearing has been scheduled for February 3, 2026, at 11:00 p.m. in Federal Court.

I participated in the proffer interview of one of the suspects responsible for providing fentanyl to a pregnant woman who died from ingesting it. This investigation is in the judicial phase, with two defendants in custody.

Utilizing a confidential source, I was able to negotiate a two-kilogram cocaine transaction from a source of supply in Chicago, Illinois. After negotiations, the source of supply drove the cocaine to Northwest Ohio where he and three other individuals from the Chicago area were detained. Two kilograms of cocaine were seized and three of the individuals were arrested. Through cell phone analysis pursuant to search warrants executed on four phones seized from the defendants, I was able to identify one of the defendants as a large-scale cocaine trafficker in the Chicago area responsible for shipments of dozens of kilograms of cocaine at a time. Two of the defendants are illegal aliens and the other is a non-citizen with legal status. These three defendants are in local custody with a one-million-dollar bond each. Federal immigration authorities are aware of the ongoing legal proceedings and have placed detainers on two of the defendants.

As a reminder, the estimated street value of the drugs seized is listed. The listed value represents the total retail value of the drugs and does not represent the value if sold wholesale.
